
The monthly supply and demand report was generally negative today as the USDA reduced soybean exports by 35 mil to 1.72 bil bushels the smallest exports seen since 2019/2020 during the trade war. The decrease in exports raised ending stocks to 315 Mil while leaving crush unchanged. Corn ending stocks grew by 10 mil as the USDA reduced Food/Industrial use . World production was lowed for both Corn and Soybeans due to the small cuts in Brazilian production and no changes made to Argentina's production from the last report. There was nothing bullish in the report


to trigger buying but the surge in Soybean Oil prices and the lower than expected CONAB number helped to support the soybean complex at the end of the day. CONAB dropped Brazil's soybean production estimate by 6 mmt to 149.4 mmt. Keep in mind that CONAB's estimates are usually light compared to the USDA. Weekly export sales released this morning were again solid for Corn but continue to be disappointing for soybeans week or week. Weather in SA looks favorable over the next 10 days as Argentina is receiving needed rains.
